

**Copy Data
Sharing
Requests**

Dataplace data sharing requestors now have the ability to copy a Data Sharing Request (DSR).
Lead data sharing requestors can now duplicate or copy their data sharing requests.

- In the Manage data requests screen, navigate to the vertical ellipses (three dots) and select 'Create a copy' which will copy the survey fields into a new data sharing request.

Foreign Individuals	Foreign individuals can now provide their required information for a data sharing request. In line with the National Security Code, when a DATA Scheme data sharing request is in the final stages, named foreign individuals now can enter relevant details via a form which will be provided securely to the Australian Security Intelligence Organisation (ASIO).
